SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Removes the provisions requiring the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue a photo identification card that includes a list of all licensing and certification programs completed by the offender.
- 2. Adds that, to the extent funding is available, the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections shall issue a card to the offender that includes a list of all vocational licensing and certification programs completed by the offender.

<u>Present law</u> requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to identify a transition specialist at each of the state correctional facilities who shall perform certain duties which include furnishing a photo identification card to an offender prior to his release.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that, to the extent funding is available, the offender shall also be issued a card that includes a list of all vocational licensing and certification programs completed by the offender while incarcerated.
