- were included in the budget on a matching basis with state funds, a corresponding decrease
- in the state matching funds may be made. Any federal funds which are classified as disaster
- or emergency under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act,
- 39 42 U.S.C.A. §1521 et seq., may be expended prior to approval of a BA-7 by the Joint
- 40 Legislative Committee on the Budget upon the secretary's certifying to the governor that any
- delay would be detrimental to the state. The Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget
- shall be notified in writing of such declaration and shall meet to consider such action, but
- 43 if it is found by the committee that such funds were not needed for an emergency
- 44 expenditure, such approval may be withdrawn and any balance remaining shall not be
- 45 expended.
