RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS: Provides relative to benefits of members of the Firefighters' Retirement System upon reemployment

## Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds language specifying that <u>proposed law</u> applies to a member who returns to service with a participating fire department.

## **Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

<u>Present law</u> provides that if a retiree from FRS returns to work in a full-time position covered by the system, payment of his retirement benefits ceases. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement for cessation of benefits applicable to an FRS retiree who returns to work in a part-time position for a fire department covered by the system.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the employee and employer contribute to the system during fulltime reemployment and that the retirement option that was selected at the first retirement cannot be changed. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires that the employee and employer contribute to the system during any part-time employment, but exclude parttime retirees from accruing credible service during his reemployment.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
