HOUSE BILL NO. 6

BY REPRESENTATIVE GREGORY MILLER

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AN ACT

To repeal R.S. 49:1401, relative to reports by agencies in the executive branch of state government; to repeal provisions providing for the automatic expiration of requirements for such reports and related provisions for extending such requirements; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 49:1401 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. No legislative mandate to produce a report shall expire pursuant to R.S. 49:1401 as enacted by the provisions of Act No. 572 of the 2018 Regular Session of the Legislature.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
