Prohibits a postsecondary education institution from withholding certain student services for financial reasons

Proposed legislation authorizes public post secondary education management boards to adopt policies prohibiting institutions from withholding a student transcript for current or former students on the grounds that the student owes a debt; condition provision of the transcript on payment or enrollment in a payment plan of the debt; charge a higher fee because the student owes a debt; or use the transcript as a debt collection tool. Further, to prohibit institutions from withholding services from a student who is in default on a federal loan, including providing grades, diplomas, course registration services, or transcripts.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated impact to expenditures of public post secondary institutions as a result of the prohibitions on collecting student debt.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There will be an indeterminable impact to revenues of public post secondary institutions to the extent the management board adopts a policy prohibiting actions institutions may take to collect outstanding student debt. Outstanding student debt may consist of unpaid tuition and fees, parking fines, housing costs, and other charges. Currently, some institutions choose to withhold transcripts until such debt is repaid. It is unknown the extent to which policies will be adopted which will impact the collections of these outstanding debts.
