The proposed constitutional amendment creates a category of protected funds which requires the enactment of a law by 2/3 of the elected members of each house of the legislature to create or modify. It further provides the legislature may redirect any projected revenues for a protected fund included in the official forecast adopted by the REC to the state general fund for the fiscal year a deficit is recognized. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors at the statewide election to be held on November 3, 2020.
