Community and Technical College System, and private businesses in La. to recognize the value that justice-involved persons bring to the workforce and society and to act with the intention to empower, train, and employ such individuals.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Request the division of administration to prioritize and fund reentry initiatives with any future federal funding related to COVID-19.
- 2. Make technical changes.

## The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Define the term "justice-involved person" as an individual who has or previously had interactions with the criminal justice system as a defendant, which includes previously incarcerated individuals or individuals on probation and parole.
