9 Louisiana where she was a member of the state championship track team for both indoor and
10 outdoor track and field; and

11 WHEREAS, she was an accomplished track athlete, completing her career at St.
12 Joseph's Academy as a four year letterman and holding several school records; and

13 WHEREAS, Sydney is a proud member of the renowned K-Y Track Club and has
14 participated in multiple Junior Olympic Championships for track and field; and

15 WHEREAS, Sydney is a member of the Baton Rouge Chapter of Jack and Jill of
16 America and also serves as the Regional Teen Editor for the South Central Region of Jack

18 WHEREAS, Jack and Jill of America, Incorporated is a membership organization
19 dedicated to nurturing future African American leaders by strengthening children through
20 leadership development, volunteer service, philanthropic giving, and civic duty; and

1 WHEREAS, Sydney is a member of the River Road Chapter of the National Charity
2 League, an organization dedicated to strengthening the mother-daughter bond while serving
3 the community of Baton Rouge; and

4 WHEREAS, for the past seven years, Sydney has dedicated her time and effort to
5 community service, averaging over one thousand hours of service, and has participated in
6 several cultural activities and leadership development opportunities; and

7 WHEREAS, Sydney and her family worship at Mount Pilgrim Missionary Baptist
8 Church where Sydney serves as a youth usher; and

9 WHEREAS, in February of 2020, Sydney represented Louisiana's Sixth
10 Congressional District as a Washington Mardi Gras Princess in Washington D.C.; and

11 WHEREAS, Sydney was recently named the 2020 Debutante Queen for the Nu

13 letter organization established by African American college trained women; and
