| 5  | WHEREAS, Leo Joseph Casanave, a lifelong resident of Lacombe, Louisiana, has              |
| 6  | been associated with the St. Tammany Parish School System and a part of the school        |
| 7  | community since he attended and graduated from St. Tammany High School in 1960; and       |
| 8  | WHEREAS, he attended Southern University in Baton Rouge, earning a Bachelor               |
| 9  | of Science in math and science in 1965; he obtained a Master of Education from            |
| 10 | Southwestern Oklahoma State University in Weatherford, Oklahoma, in 1970; and he          |
| 11 | continued his education by receiving a Plus 30 from Southern University in Baton Rouge,   |
| 12 | while also attending Loyola University, Southern University of New Orleans, Prairie View  |
| 13 | A&M University, and Northwestern State University; and                                    |
| 14 | WHEREAS, Mr. Casanave began his career as a teacher in 1965 at St. Tammany                |
| 15 | High School where he taught math and science for five years; he became the school         |
| 16 | counselor in 1970, and was a counselor until he retired in 2004 after forty plus years of |

| 18 | WHEREAS, in 2007, he returned to St. Tammany Junior High School as an                     |

| 3  | Partnership Act (JTPA) for twenty-eight years where he placed over six thousand youth and     |
| 4  | adults with work opportunities; and   |
| 5  | WHEREAS, he also managed the St. Tammany Parish Federal Credit Union for                      |
| 6  | twenty-seven years; and   |
| 7  | WHEREAS, Mr. Casanave is currently a St. Tammany Parish Fire Department                       |
| 8  | District #3 commissioner, where he serves as secretary, a volunteer for the Lacombe           |
| 9  | Recreational Department coach Little League baseball; a member of Phi Delta Kappa,            |
| 10 | Southern University Alumni Association, and Knights of Columbus of Slidell, as well as a      |
| 11 | charter member of Men of Our Town Civic and Social Club; and                                  |
| 12 | WHEREAS, he is a member of Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church in Lacombe                   |
| 13 | and a longtime member of the senior choir; is a former board member and past president of     |
| 14 | Boys' and Girls' Club of Slidell, and was a member of the feasibility study for the Boys' and |
| 15 | Girls' Club of Slidell and Pope John Paul High School; and                                    |
| 16 | WHEREAS, Leo is married to Anjo Smith Casanave and they celebrated their                      |
| 17 | fifty-third wedding anniversary on June 3, 2020; this union created two children, Donovan     |
| 18 | Videl and Donnis Vanee'; one daughter-in-law, Amber; one five-year-old grandson, Aden         |
| 19 | Donovan; one son-in-law, Reggie; and  |
| 20 | WHEREAS, Mr. Casanave has taught or counseled four generations of children in                 |
| 21 | many families; he has made a difference in the lives of many; and                             |
| 22 | WHEREAS, in retirement, Leo plans to spend time with his grandson, travel, fish,              |
| 23 | garden, and just enjoy his life; and  |
| 24 | WHEREAS, through Mr. Casanave's many years of selfless service to the St.                     |
| 25 | Tammany Parish School System and the people of St. Tammany Parish, he proved to be an         |
| 26 | educator of boundless energy and ability, a person of great empathy and vision, and a teacher |
| 27 | whose devotion to education has been a priceless gift to the public school system of St.      |
| 28 | Tammany Parish and the state of Louisiana, and merits a special measure of commendation.      |
