<u>Prior law</u> required that the clerks of court exercising the powers and duties of the recorder of mortgages keep a record of all proceedings affecting any drainage district or sub-drainage district or ganized under the drainage laws of La.

<u>Prior law</u> required the register of conveyances of Orleans Parish and clerks of court to keep an alphabetical index of all persons filing certificates with regard to assumed business names and charge a filing fee as well as a fee for the issuance of certified copies.

<u>Prior law</u> further provided that a copy of a duly certified certificate shall be presumptive evidence of the facts contained in it.

<u>New law</u> repeals prior law.

Effective Aug. 1, 2020.
