## **ACT 164 (HB 12)**

<u>Existing law</u> provides that if a retiree from Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS) returns to work in a full-time position covered by the system, payment of his retirement benefits ceases. Requires the employee and the employer to make contributions toward creditable service during such reemployment. <u>New law</u> limits the applicability of <u>existing law</u> to retirees who return to work for a fire department of an employer covered by the system.

<u>New law</u> provides that if a retiree from FRS returns to work in a part-time position for a fire department of an employer covered by the system, employee and employer contributions shall be remitted to the system, but the retiree shall not accrue creditable service. Requires a refund of the employee's contributions.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 11, 2020).
