The proposed resolution directs the Legislative Budgetary Control Council (LBCC) to review the compensation of legislative assistants and to establish a salary schedule that is competitive with the marketplace no later than April 12, 2021.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure since this resolution merely directs the LBCC to review the compensation of assistants and establish a salary schedule no later than April 12, 2021. To the extent the LBCC establishes a salary schedule at rates higher than baseline, there is a potential increase in SGF expenditures for the Legislature. Any such increase is speculative and would require establishment of a salary schedule by the LBCC and an appropriation increase to fund the pay adjustments presumably beginning in FY 22.
