WHEREAS, the Bernhards resided in Baton Rouge until moving to Lafayette a few years later to establish their family home and mechanical contracting business; and

WHEREAS, for over fifty years, Jimmy was a leader of Bernhard Mechanical Contractors, one of the largest and oldest companies in the state of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, he was an active and dedicated member of Holy Cross Catholic Church and an integral part of the Knights of Columbus, holding various statewide offices as well as being a Grand Knight; and

WHEREAS, Jimmy chaired many charitable events in Lafayette, the most unique being a fundraiser for Cathedral Carmel High School which hosted the famous Harlem Globetrotters as entertainment; and

WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife, Barbara, and their children, Jim Bernhard Jr. and wife Dana Reneau Bernhard, Janice Bernhard Slaughter, Kenneth "Kenny" Bernhard and wife Elaine Wimberly Bernhard; and Peggy Elaine Bernhard; his brother, Charles R.
