APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #11)

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make certain reductions from certain sources to be allocated to  
3 designated agencies and purposes in specific amounts for the making of  
4 supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021; to provide for an effective  
5 date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the Louisiana Main  
8 Street Recovery Fund for the purpose of making supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year  
9 2020-2021.

12 Payable out of the State General Fund by Statutory  
13 Dedications out of the Louisiana Main Street  
14 Recovery Fund to the Board of Regents for the  
15 purchase of eleven mechanical chest compression

17 Provided, however, that the funds appropriated from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery  
18 Program shall be used to supply the following post-secondary education institutions with  
19 mechanical chest compression devices: Grambling State University, Louisiana State  
20 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, Louisiana Tech University, McNeese  
21 State University, Nicholls State University, Northwestern State University, Southeastern  
22 Louisiana University, Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College,  
23 University of Louisiana at Lafayette, University of Louisiana at Monroe, University of New  
24 Orleans.

## OTHER REQUIREMENTS

**20-945 STATE AID TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITIES**

The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the means of finance for the Miscellaneous Aid Program, as contained in Act No. 1 of the 2020 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, by reducing the appropriation out of the State General Fund by Statutory Dedications out of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund by (\$220,000).

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
