

1 WHEREAS, Judge Amy Coney Barrett has worked in both private trial and appellate
2 litigation in Washington, D.C.; during this time, she also worked for more than fifteen years
3 in academia, including at her alma mater, Notre Dame Law School, and has been published
4 in several prominent journals including the Columbia Law Review, Virginia Law Review,
5 and Texas Law Review; and

6 WHEREAS, Judge Amy Coney Barrett has earned accolades and bipartisan praise
7 for her character and work ethic and has demonstrated a steadfast dedication to upholding
8 the United States Constitution as written and not legislating from the bench; her excellent
9 judicial record shows she will protect the rights of Americans and defend the rule of law.

10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
11 memorialize the United States Senate to take such actions as are necessary to confirm the
12 nomination of Judge Amy Coney Barrett to the United States Supreme Court.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
14 presiding officers of the Senate and to the Honorable Bill Cassidy and the Honorable John
15 Kennedy.
