4 WHEREAS, poll commissioners are essential to the success of any election, and
5 there are never enough capable, committed residents willing to participate in the election
6 process by working as poll commissioners on election day; it is vital that more citizens be
7 encouraged and recruited to participate in the electoral process at the precinct level.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
9 urge and request the clerks of court to develop and utilize innovative strategies to recruit
10 commissioners for polling places.
