

1 implementation of a salary schedule for legislative assistants and to provide a mechanism
2 to factor in other governmental experience of a legislative assistant and authorized the
3 council to make adjustments to the salary schedule as necessary, became effective on July
4 1, 2008; and

5 WHEREAS, many legislators continue to have a difficult time finding qualified
6 legislative assistants to work for them and the legislature due to the existing salary
7 allotments available to them for that purpose.

8 THEREFORE, the Legislature of Louisiana requests the House Committee on House
9 and Governmental Affairs and the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs
10 to meet and to function as a joint committee to study issues related to the compensation
11 allocated to each legislator for legislative assistants, and to report the findings of the joint
12 committee to the Legislative Budgetary Control Council and to the legislature prior to the
13 convening of the 2021 Regular Session of the Legislature.
