APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML. Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #11)

DIGEST

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Require that the funds appropriated to the Louisiana Public Defender Board Program for the renovation or purchase of office space for district defenders offices shall not be expended unless a plan for such expenditures is approved by JLCB.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Increase appropriations as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$7,657,446; Interagency Transfers by \$9,950,246; Statutory Dedications by \$7,200,246; and Federal Funds by \$26,650,440.
- 2. Reallocate funds from the Jefferson Parish Convention Center Fund included in Act No. 1 of the 2020 1st Extraordinary Session.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the reengrossed bill

- 1. Directs the commissioner of administration to reduce \$92 million in Federal Funds from CARES Act funding in GOHSEP.
- 2. Adjusts the means of financing in the Louisiana Department of Health.
- 3. Directs \$115.4 million for deposit into the Unemployment Compensation Fund.
- 4. Directs \$7 million State General Fund to restore funding for local government initiatives.
- 5. Directs \$5 million to the Coronavirus Local Recovery Allocation Fund.
- 6. Reduces Judiciary Expenses by \$2 million out of CARES Act monies, replaced by \$2.4 million in State General Fund from GO bond debt refinancing.

7.	Reduces \$44.8 million across state government of which \$25 million is State
	General Fund. This State General Fund will be deposited into the Unemployment
	Compensation Fund, to bring the total to \$115.4 million.

8. Directs \$250,000 to CPRA from DOTD for sonar scanning in Southwest Pass.
