2	To commend the Louisiana National Guard for its hard work, commitment, selfless
3	dedication, and lifesaving efforts throughout 2020.
4	WHEREAS, during this tumultuous year, the Louisiana National Guard has
5	performed exemplary work and displayed tremendous dedication through its efforts to
6	protect the lives and welfare of Louisianians; and
7	WHEREAS, the tireless professionalism of our soldiers and airmen in supporting the
8	state's initial response to the COVID-19 crisis, combating the threats of criminals and
9	nefarious actors to our cyber domain, and responding to the devastation of Hurricanes Laura
10	and Delta demonstrate the immeasurable value of the men and women of the Louisiana
11	National Guard; and
12	WHEREAS, after Hurricane Laura, the Louisiana National Guard distributed more
13	than five million meals-ready-to-eat, over seven million liters of water, more than one
14	million bags of ice, and nearly two hundred thousand tarps to victims of the storm; and
15	WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 crisis, the Guard has administered nearly
16	two hundred fifty thousand tests, packed nearly sixteen million pounds of food at food
17	banks, and delivered over fifty-four million units of personal protective equipment; and
18	WHEREAS, the Louisiana National Guard has supported missions involving
19	transportation, communications, public works and engineering, traffic control, and
20	generators and power supply; it has cleared eighteen hundred miles of roadway of hurricane
21	debris; and
