CONDOLENCES: Expresses condolences on the death of Geoffrey Hingle

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Geoffrey
3 Hingle.

WHEREAS, Geoffrey Choate Hingle was born on September 2, 1956, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to Elmira Avery Hingle and Alvin Joseph Hingle; his father was a Purple Heart combat veteran of World War II and a native of Plaquemines Parish; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Hingle was a 1974 graduate of Broadmoor High School in Baton
8 Rouge, and he attended Louisiana State University, where he was a proud member of the
9 Sigma Chi Fraternity; he also served as an assistant weight training coach for LSU athletics;
10 he never passed up an opportunity to cheer on the LSU Tigers and even earned a spot on the
11 school's cheerleading squad; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Hingle completed his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering at
13 Southern University and, afterwards, worked with General Dynamics/Lockheed Martin;
14 while working, he also earned two master's degrees and completed his Ph.D. at Southern
15 Methodist University; his incredible work ethic and intelligence quickly earned him the title
16 of chief of systems engineering over weapons systems and avionics for General
17 Dynamics/Lockheed Martin's F-16 and F-22 fighter jet programs; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Hingle returned to Louisiana with his family in 1997, and he began
19 a successful entrepreneurial career; he founded PMOLink, LLC, an engineering and
20 consulting firm, and created dozens of jobs across southeast Louisiana; he also trained and

1 educated thousands of professionals in project management, process management, and
2 project scheduling and controls; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Hingle was also a man of incredible faith who embodied grace and
4 love in all of his encounters; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Hingle is survived by his wife of thirty-seven years, Lisa Pirello
6 Hingle; three sons, Geoffrey Choate Hingle, Jr., Nicholas Joseph Hingle, and Jacob
7 Alexander Hingle; a sister, Tara Avery Hingle Elkins; daughters-in-law, Elizabeth Burns
8 Hingle and Kayla Ward Hingle; and three grandchildren, Harper Rose Hingle, Harrison Dale
9 Hingle, and Hattie Marie Hingle; he will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
11 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express sincere condolences on the death of Geoffrey
12 Hingle and does hereby extend sincere hopes and wishes that his family find comfort during
13 this difficult time.
