Abstract: Provides for civil liability of interactive computer services that restrict a user's account or content based on race, gender, political ideology, or religious beliefs.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for civil liability for the owner, operator, or provider of an interactive computer service who restricts a user's account or content based on race, gender, political ideology, or religious beliefs.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the interactive computer service must provide written notice to the user within 24 hours of restriction.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the interactive computer service shall be liable to a user whose account or content was restricted and a user who reasonably would have received or viewed another user's content but for the restriction.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a prescription of two years from when the violation was discovered or reasonably should have been discovered.

Proposed law provides for a jury trial.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for damages including actual damages, statutory damages of \$50,000 per violation, and court costs, fees, and reasonable attorney fees.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the attorney general to investigate alleged violations.

<u>Proposed law</u> is only applicable to interactive computer services with more than 10,000,000 users.
