2	To enact Code of Civil Procedure Art. 4566(K), relative to the management of affairs of the
3	interdict; to provide for the establishment and maintenance of deposit accounts; and
4	to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Code of Civil Procedure Art. 4566(K) is hereby enacted to read as
7	follows:
8	Art. 4566. Management of affairs of the interdict
9	* * *
10	K. Notwithstanding the requirements of Article 4270 or any other
11	provision of law to the contrary, a curator shall have authority to establish and
12	maintain deposit accounts in the name of the "curator on behalf of the
13	interdict", unless the letters of curatorship expressly limit such authority.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the management of affairs of the interdict and provides that the relationship between the interdict and curator is the same as that between the minor and tutor.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the procedure for investing, reinvesting, or withdrawing funds on behalf of a minor.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a curator shall have authority to establish and maintain deposit accounts in the name of the "curator on behalf of the interdict", unless the letters of curatorship expressly limit such authority.
