**Abstract:** Provides that the local superintendent's appointment of a principal is subject to the approval of the school board, which shall occur at a public meeting where there is an opportunity for public comment.

<u>Present law</u> provides for each school principal to be appointed by the local school superintendent and serve as the administrative officer of the school to which he is assigned. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but subjects the appointment to the approval of the local school board as follows:

- (1) Requires the superintendent to recommend a candidate to fill each vacancy in a school principal position to the board at an open public meeting that has been properly noticed.
- (2) Requires the school board to provide an opportunity for public comment prior to voting to approve or disapprove the appointment of the candidate recommended by the superintendent.
