**Abstract:** Increases the number of commissioners for the presidential preference primary election.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in any statewide presidential preference primary election, the number of election commissioners required at each precinct is one commissioner-in-charge and two commissioners.

Proposed law repeals present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that for gubernatorial and congressional elections, there shall be four commissioners for precincts with more than 300 active registered voters and three commissioners for precincts with 300 active registered voters or less.

Proposed law makes present law applicable to presidential preference primary elections.

Effective Feb. 1, 2022.
