HEALTH DEPARTMENT. Provides relative to the prioritization of health equity by the Louisiana Department of Health. (8/1/21)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 40:1263, relative to equity in health care services; to provide for the duties of
3	the Louisiana Department of Health; to provide for best practices and protocols for
4	treating communities with underlying medical conditions and health disparities; and
5	to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 40:1263 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1263. Health equity; duties of the Louisiana Department of Health
9	A. The Louisiana Department of Health, in addition to the other powers
10	and duties conferred upon it by law, shall serve as a foundation and resource for
11	addressing health care disparities in vulnerable populations, and contribute to
12	the progression and improvement of Louisiana's health care rankings.
13	B. As part of carrying out the duties provided for in Subsection A of this
14	Section, the Louisiana Department of Health shall make available to health care
15	professionals the best practices and protocols for treating communities with
16	underlying medical conditions and health disparities by doing all of the
17	following:

1 (1) Examining opportunities which provide greater access to high 2 quality medical care and improve health outcomes. 3 Performing a comprehensive evidenced-based analysis of the determinants of health equity that influence racial health disparities. 4 Performing a comprehensive evidenced-based analysis of 5 interventions that positively impact health equity and address disparities. 6 7 (4) Performing a comprehensive examination of the population 8 dynamics that are indicative of health equity and disparities. 9 (5) Promoting health awareness educational media campaigns. 10 C. To assist in carrying out its duties pursuant to this Section, the 11 Louisiana Department of Health may analyze any other relevant data which will add to the work of the department, seek input from any interested parties 12 13 including but not limited to licensed health care professionals, advocates, and concerned citizens, pursue any relevant topics including policies and laws that 14 impact health disparities, and promote community outreach and extension 15 16 activities.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), in addition to the other powers and duties conferred upon it by law, shall serve as a foundation and resource for addressing health care disparities in vulnerable populations, and contribute to the progression and improvement of Louisiana's health care rankings.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that LDH shall make available to health care professionals the best practices and protocols for treating communities with underlying medical conditions and health disparities by doing certain enumerated tasks.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that LDH may analyze any other relevant data which will add to the work of the department, seek input from any interested parties including but not limited to licensed health care professionals, advocates, and concerned citizens, pursue any relevant topics including policies and laws that impact health disparities, and promote community outreach and extension activities.
