2	To enact R.S. 49:147, relative to access to state facilities; to prohibit denial of access to state
3	facilities based on COVID-19 vaccination status; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 49:147 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§147. Access to state facilities; discrimination prohibited
7	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no person
8	shall be denied access to a state-owned, state-funded, or state-operated facility
9	based on whether the person has received a COVID-19 vaccination.
