Abstract: Exempts certain persons from the crime of illegal carrying of weapons and replaces the requirement that a person possess a permit issued by the state of La. in order to carry a concealed handgun in the state of La. with the requirement that a person complete a 60 minute online concealed handgun education course.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 14:95) prohibits the carrying of a concealed firearm, provides for criminal penalties, and provides for certain exceptions to the offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates an exception to this prohibition for a person who is 21 years of age or older and who is not prohibited from possessing a firearm under any federal or state law.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 40:1379.3) provides that La. residents who meet certain eligibility requirements may apply for and be issued a concealed handgun permit authorizing the person to carry a concealed handgun on his person in the state of La.

<u>Present law</u> requires the person to possess a valid concealed handgun permit issued by the state of La. in order to carry a concealed handgun in the state of La.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> from requiring that a person possess a permit issued by the state of La. in order to carry a concealed handgun in the state of La. to requiring that a person complete a 60 minute online concealed handgun education course at no cost to La. residents created by state police.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the 60 minute online concealed handgun course to include the following topics:

- (1) Concealed handgun basics and nomenclature.
- (2) Firearm free zones.
- (3) Use of deadly force.
- (4) Interactions with law enforcement officers.
