Governor Billy Nungesser said that "Her contributions to tourism and economic development in Southwest Louisiana have left a positive and permanent mark noted as progress"; and WHEREAS, Marion "Butch" Fox was an exemplary Louisianian; she devoted her life's work to promoting the state both domestically and abroad, and she will be deeply missed but certainly never forgotten.
