A RESOLUTION

To recognize April 20, 2021, as Young Marines Day at the state capitol and to commend the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office Young Marines unit on being recognized as National Unit of the Year.

WHEREAS, the Young Marines is a national youth organization whose mission is to positively impact America's future by providing quality youth development programs for boys and girls that nurture and develop responsible citizens who enjoy and promote a healthy and drug-free lifestyle; and
