# "§2370.16 Exemption

Any broadband project which is financed in whole or part through the GUMBO program or by any funds administered or disbursed by or through the office shall not be a "covered service" under the Local Government Fair Competition Act, La. R.S. 45:844.41 et seq.

### §2370.17 Prohibitions

A local government that finances a broadband project in whole or part through the GUMBO program or by any funds administered or disbursed by or through the office may not make or grant any undue or unreasonable preference to itself or any private provider of broadband services, and shall apply without discrimination as to itself and to any private provider the local government's ordinances, rules, and policies, including those relating to obligation to serve, access to public rights of way, permitting, performance bonding, reporting, and quality of service."
