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Abstract: Makes discretionary the withholding of state income taxes on federal disaster unemployment compensation benefits.

<u>Present law</u> provides that if a claimant is eligible to receive any federal disaster unemployment assistance in addition to the maximum weekly benefit amounts established in <u>present law</u>, then the claimant, when filing a claim for state unemployment compensation benefits, shall be required to withhold state income taxes at the time the claim is filed.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> by providing that instead of requiring the claimant to withhold state income taxes, <u>proposed law</u> provides that the claimant may elect to withhold state income taxes at the time the claim is filed.
