5	WHEREAS, R.S. 24:513(P) provides that upon request, either pursuant to a
6	concurrent resolution adopted by the legislature or a written joint request from the speaker
7	of the House of Representatives and the president of the Senate, an auditee of state
8	government shall provide the legislative auditor with electronic access to a synchronized
9	copy of the data points as they exist in the auditee's system, including those regarding
10	expenditures, revenues, contracts, and financial matters.
11	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
12	request and direct the division of administration to provide the legislative auditor with
13	electronic access to a synchronized copy of the datapoints in the LaGov Enterprise Resource
14	Planning system pursuant to R.S. 24:513(P).
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
16	commissioner of administration and the legislative auditor.
