1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 14, change "**Section, "advertisement for legal services"**" to the following:

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 15, after "**through**" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 16 and
7 insert "**a media entity.**"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 17, delete "**television,**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, delete line 1 and on line 2, delete "**communication**" and insert "**a media entity**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 2, between lines 3 and 4 insert:

14 **"(2) "Media entity" means a radio broadcast station, television broadcast**
15 **station, cable television company, newspaper company, periodical company,**
16 **billboard company, advertisement agency, media platform, or bona fide news**
17 **or public interest website operator."**

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 4, line 7, delete "**any and**"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 7

21 On page 4, between lines 21 and 22 insert:

22 **"H.(1) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to any media entity**
23 **responsible for the production or publication of any advertisement found to be**
24 **in violation of this Section.**
25 **(2) The carriage, distribution, transmission, or display of any advertisement,**
26 **including but not limited to those for legal services, by a media entity shall not**
27 **be considered a violation of this Section."**
