1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 6, at the beginning of line 26, change "and the" to "<u>communication between</u>
institutions regarding incidents of power-based violence, and the provision of"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 8, at the end of line 4, delete "communicate", delete lines 5-15, and insert the 6 following:

7	"with each other regarding transfer of students against whom disciplinary
8	action has been taken as a result of a code of conduct violation relating to sexually-
9	oriented criminal offenses.
10	(b) The Board of Regents' Uniform Policy on Sexual Assault shall require
11	that institutions withhold transcripts of students seeking a transfer with pending
12	disciplinary action relative to sexually-oriented criminal offenses, until such
13	investigation and adjudication is complete. implement a uniform transcript notation
14	and communication policy to effectuate communication regarding the transfer of a
15	student who is the subject of a pending power-based violence complaint or who has
16	been found responsible for an incident of power-based violence pursuant to the
17	institution's investigative and adjudication process. The notation and communication
18	policy shall be developed by the Board of Regents, in consultation with the
19	postsecondary education management boards. The policy shall include procedures
20	relative to the withholding of transcripts during the investigative and adjudication
21	process."
