



1           WHEREAS, the setting may interact with both subject and examiner characteristics  
2 to affect the validity of the polygraph test.

3           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana requests the  
4 House Committee on Judiciary, or a subcommittee thereof, and the Senate Committee on  
5 Judiciary B, or a subcommittee thereof, to meet and to function as a joint committee to study  
6 procedures for law enforcement officers under investigation who are required to submit to  
7 a polygraph and to study the effects of a representative being present while the law  
8 enforcement officer submits to a polygraph.
