2	To commend the Eleanor McMain Secondary School Mustangs on winning the 2021 4A
3	State Championship in boys basketball.
4	WHEREAS, the 2021 boys basketball season ended as every player, parent, fan, and
5	coach would have wanted; the McMain Mustangs boys basketball team won the Louisiana
6	High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) Class 4A State Championship at Burton
7	Coliseum in Lake Charles, Louisiana, on Saturday, March 14, 2021, in the most exciting
8	way; and
9	WHEREAS, this boys basketball championship was the first basketball state
10	championship to be played between two New Orleans public schools; and
11	WHEREAS, the Mustangs became state champions by defeating top-seeded George
12	Washington Carver High School in a game that had five lead changes in the final three
13	minutes before sophomore Corey Chest scored the winning point from the free-throw line
14	with 0.7 seconds left to play; and
15	WHEREAS, the Mustangs defeated Carver by a score of forty-nine to forty-eight to
16	clinch the championship; and
17	WHEREAS, with this victory, the mustangs have earned their first state title during
18	an unprecedented season under the leadership of Coach Steven Kelly and his amazing

supporting staff and coaches; and

2	WHEREAS, this honor was earned by each member of the McMain Mustangs team,
3	from Head Coach Steven Kelly and his staff of assistant coaches, Bryan Hammond, Willie
4	Jones, Patrick Taylor, and Jemark Wise, to the players themselves: Christian Pichon, Nicolas
5	Kaigler, Terwin Track, Alex Hammond, Malik Rhinehard, Taj Gilyot, Corey Chest, Aiden
6	Bevrotte, Donte Briggs, Corey Holmes, Brandon Vigne, and Damien McCoy; and
7	WHEREAS, Coach Kelly and his staff have instilled an ethic of winning in these fine
8	young men and has demonstrated leadership and motivational skills that have led to success
9	both on and off the court for the McMain Mustangs; and
10	WHEREAS, the coaches and players sacrificed and spent countless hours preparing
11	for this capstone achievement that will forever be memorialized in Louisiana high school
12	sports history; and
13	WHEREAS, the coaches and players acknowledged that they could not have
14	accomplished this amazing feat without a lot of hard work, dedication, teamwork, support
15	from their parents and the surrounding community, especially considering the additional
16	challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic; and
17	WHEREAS, with the leadership of Coach Kelly, the McMain Mustangs brought the
18	state championship trophy home to their school, proud parents, and their supportive
19	community; and
20	WHEREAS, the team dedicated the win to all of the students, faculty, staff, and
21	coaches at the school; and
22	WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the well-deserved title the Mustangs have
23	earned, to commend the team for the talent and ability they have displayed, particularly at
24	the most difficult level of competition, and to express sincere and heartfelt congratulations
25	to team members and the coaching staff for the merits earned and the sportsmanship shown
26	while achieving the highest state boys basketball honor possible for Eleanor McMain
27	Secondary School.
