1	A RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to take all
3	necessary actions to provide that no measure of student growth be used in the
4	evaluation of teachers for the 2020-2021 school year.
5	WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 global health pandemic, the 2020-2021 school
6	year has been extremely challenging for students, families, and teachers; and
7	WHEREAS, natural disasters also drastically disrupted the school year in multiple
8	parishes, including Hurricanes Marco, Laura, Sally, Beta, and Delta in 2020 and the winter
9	storm of February 2021; and
10	WHEREAS, students across the state have been exposed to different levels of in-
11	person instruction, online instruction, and instruction in a hybrid format of both in-person
12	and online instruction; and
13	WHEREAS, the disruption of education due to COVID-19 and extraordinary weather
14	events during the 2020-2021 school year will likely result in an inaccurate measure of
15	educational outcomes, and inaccurate measures should not be used as a basis for the
16	evaluation of teachers.
17	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
18	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the State Board of Elementary and
19	Secondary Education to take all necessary actions to provide that no measure of student
20	growth be used in the evaluation of teachers for the 2020-2021 school year.
