(b) He shall thereupon apply, in compliance with this Section, the proper procedure from the table in Subsection I of this Section to such next calendar year beginning January first for maximum dollar amount of "wages", maximum weekly benefit amount, with any applicable discounts under R.S. 23:1592, and <a href="mailto:publish annually">publish annually</a> the formula for computation of benefits.
