A RESOLUTION

To commend the Choudrant High School baseball team on winning the Louisiana High School Athletic Association 2021 Class B state championship.

WHEREAS, the top-seeded Choudrant High School Aggies defeated third-seeded Elizabeth High School, 6-1, to capture the 2021 Class B state title; and

WHEREAS, the Aggies found their bats down the stretch for a five-run sixth inning, breaking up a five-inning pitcher's duel; and

WHEREAS, Braden Jones was named the game's Most Outstanding Player after pitching seven complete innings and surrendering only one unearned run; and
