CHILDREN: Provides relative to the imposition of court costs in proceedings involving children

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Limits <u>proposed law</u> (R.S. 13:1595.3(C)) to apply <u>from</u> July 1, 2021, <u>to</u> June 30, 2026, and removes all other provisions of <u>proposed law</u>.
- 3. Adds to <u>proposed law</u> (R.S. 13:1595.3(C)) cross-references to numerous <u>present</u> <u>law</u> fees, costs, and taxes in order to eliminate such fees, costs, and taxes.
- 4. Provides that the La. Supreme Court shall distribute copies of the Act to all La. courts no later than July 1, 2021.
- 5. Provides that the Act shall become effective upon signature of the governor.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Under <u>present law</u>, courts are required or allowed to assess administrative fees, costs, and taxes in juvenile delinquency cases. Courts impose these fees, costs, and taxes on juveniles or their parents or guardians.

<u>Proposed law</u> eliminates certain fees, costs, and taxes in juvenile delinquency cases including costs for juvenile detention centers, fees imposed for transcript requests, fees imposed for an order for a physical or mental examination, and other fees as provided by <u>present law</u> (R.S. 15:910, 1086, 1093, 1094.7 and 1097.7, R.S. 47:299.1, Ch.C. Arts. 320, 321, 335, 405, 607, 774, 781.1, 783, 793.4, 809, 811,2, 839, 848, 868, 888, 896, 897, 899, 901.1 and 924, and C.Cr.P. Art. 887).

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
