7	WHEREAS, a Louisiana native and graduate of Welsh High School, Gregg received
8	his Bachelor of Science degree from LSU in 1980 and went on to become a graduate of the
9	Economic Development Institute at the University of Oklahoma and the Community
10	Development Institute at the University of Central Arkansas; and
11	WHEREAS, he received a Professional Community Developer Certification from
12	the Community Development Council and is a graduate of Leadership Lafayette V and
13	Leadership Louisiana; and
14	WHEREAS, Gregg began his career as an economic developer with Gulf States
15	Utilities in Lake Charles and developed a niche for business growth and expansion; he was
16	very successful guiding SWLA "Team City" communities, and in 1992, Site Selection and
17	Industrial Development Magazine selected GSU's business development group as one of the
18	top ten economic development groups in the United States; and

1 WHEREAS, in July 1995, Gregg was appointed president and CEO of the Lafayette 2 Economic Development Authority (LEDA) and in his years there, he has contributed 3 substantially to the economic growth and stability of Lafayette, Acadiana, and Louisiana 4 through the organization's role in retaining and attracting some of the area's most influential businesses; and 5 WHEREAS, his accomplishments have been highlighted by awards such as the 6 7 Richard E.
