RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

SR 22 2021 Regular Session Jackson

Creates a group to study the voting rights of persons incarcerated prior to trial and requires the group to report to the Senate and the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library by 2/1/22.

Study group to include:

- (1) The governor, or his designee.
- (2) The secretary of state, or his designee.
- (3) The deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, corrections services, or his designee.
- (4) The state public defender, or his designee.
- (5) The executive director of the La. District Attorneys Association, or his designee.
- (6) The executive director of the La. Sheriffs' Association, or his designee.
- (7) The executive director of the La. Association of Chiefs of Police, or his designee.
- (8) The executive director of the ACLU of Louisiana, or his designee.
- (9) The president of the NAACP, Louisiana State Conference, or his designee.
- (10) The executive director of Voice of the Experienced, or his designee.

Provides that the senator representing Senate District No. 34 is to call the first meeting of the study group.
