EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an SGR expenditure increase to the LA Housing Corporation (LHC) as a result of its board of directors increasing by two. The agency reports it will need \$9,338 in FY 22, \$9,431 in FY 23, \$9,525 in FY 24, \$9,620 in FY 25, and \$9,716 in FY 26. The agency assumed a 1 percent annual increase in cost for expenses to cover normal adjustments in the cost of goods and services.

NOTE: \$4,669 average amount spent per board member x 2 new board members = \$9,338

The agency reports that it expended \$4,669 on average over the past three (3) years per board member on items such as per diem payments, staff travel for conferences and related cost associated with that travel for board meetings and other agency related discussions, court reporting services related to public meetings, the postage cost for mailing documents and packages, supplies and other work-related charges.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
