<u>Prior law</u> placed the marshal of the city of Ruston under a separate fee schedule from the marshals.

<u>New law</u> changes the fees collected by the marshal of the city of Ruston by placing the marshal within the general fee schedules of marshals and constables (R.S. 13:5807) and by removing the authority of the marshal of the city of Ruston to collect certain fees and costs under a separate authority (R.S. 13:5807.5).

<u>New law</u> provides that in accordance with <u>existing law</u>, the increase in court costs or fees as provided by <u>new law</u> only becomes effective if and when the Judicial Council provides a favorable recommendation in the Judicial Council 2022 Report to the Louisiana Legislature.

Effective August 1, 2021.
