<u>Prior law</u> provided the qualification process for the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to execute design-build contracts. Required the DOTD to submit projects selected for use of design-build to the House and Senate transportation committees.

<u>New law</u> modifies <u>prior law</u> by removing the requirement for the House and Senate transportation, highways, and public works committees approval process.

<u>Prior law</u> required that a notice of intent to request letters of interest for a design-build project be distributed by the department through advertisement on the DOTD website.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and adds that a pool of pre-qualified design builders must remain pre-qualified for up to two years.

<u>Existing law</u> requires all notices of intent be advertised a minimum of 10 days prior to the deadline for receipt of responses and contain a description of the project.

<u>New law</u> expands the notice of intent requirements to include the type of work. Further adds experience in the type of work as a consideration for the qualifications evaluation committee when evaluating responses to the request for qualifications for design-build services.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 15, 2021).
