RETIREMENT SYSTEMS: Prohibits retirement systems from investing in companies that boycott energy companies

AN ACT

2 To enact Subpart P of Part II of Chapter 4 of Title 11 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 3 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 11:331, relative to investments made by state and 4 statewide retirement systems; to prohibit retirement systems from investing in 5 companies that do not do business with or enter contracts with energy companies; 6 to provide for costs; and to provide for related matters. 7 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published 8 as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution 9 of Louisiana. 10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 11 Section 1. Subpart P of Part II of Chapter 4 of Title 11 of the Louisiana Revised 12 Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 11:331, is hereby enacted to read as follows: SUBPART P. PROHIBITED INVESTMENTS 13 14 §331. Prohibition on investing in certain companies 15 Notwithstanding R.S. 11:263, no retirement system, plan, or fund shall invest 16 system funds in a company that has a policy that prohibits the company from 17 investing in, doing business with, or entering contracts with energy companies or 18 with any class or group of companies within the energy sector.

- (2) Doing business with energy companies.
- (3) Entering contracts with energy companies.
