Abstract: Provides relative to the determination of which schools participating in the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program receive an accountability performance score.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program, through which students attend participating schools through state-funded scholarships. Requires the state Dept. of Education to develop of accountability system for the program; this accountability system is provided in <u>present administrative rule</u> adopted by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and includes the assignment of a "scholarship cohort index", which is similar to a school performance score and is based on the performance of scholarship recipients on state assessments; schools receive this index if they meet certain thresholds in terms a minimum number of students in the scholarship cohort in tested grades.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits assignment of a performance score to a school unless at least 25% percent of the students in tested grades are scholarship recipients.
