**Abstract:** Increases the number of licenses for pharmacies dispensing marijuana for therapeutic use.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the La. Board of Pharmacy shall develop a specialty license for pharmacies dispensing marijuana for therapeutic use. <u>Present law</u> limits the number of such licenses granted in the state to no more than 10 licenses.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the limit on the number of licenses  $\underline{\text{from}}$  no more than  $10 \underline{\text{to}}$  no more than  $20 \underline{\text{licenses}}$ .
