**Abstract:** Removes imprisonment from penalty provisions for the unauthorized practice of medicine.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any person who violates <u>present law</u>, relative to the practice of medicine, surgery, and midwifery, shall, for each offense, be fined no less than \$250 nor more than \$500, or imprisoned for no less than 10 days nor more than 5 months, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes imprisonment from the penalty provisions and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
