Harris

<u>Present law</u> provides for each member of a parish board of election supervisors to receive \$50 for each day actually spent in the performance of his duties in preparing for and supervising each election held in the parish.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and increases the amount of compensation received to \$150 per day.

<u>Present law</u> provides for each election commissioner-in-charge of more than one precinct at the polling place on election day to receive \$300.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for each election commissioner-in-charge of more than one precinct at the polling place on election day to receive \$350.

<u>Present law</u> provides for election commissioners who assist registrars of voters with the conduct of early voting to be paid \$100 in accordance with the provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for election commissioners who assist registrars of voters with the conduct of early voting to be paid \$150.
